To meet UND and SMHS Goal 6, the OT department has identified an increase in efforts regarding department opportunities for military personnel and families. This goal will be achieved by 1) identifying key individuals at the base with which to establish collaborative educational opportunities, 2) developing a marketing campaign in collaboration with the Alumni and Public Relations staff that will target potential long-term applicants through recruitment at the base middle school, and 3) providing support for deployed students enrolled in the OT program. Academic advisors remain in contact with deployed students to provide information regarding necessary paperwork and completion requirements. Advisors and department personnel contact deployed students routinely to encourage the students during their deployment and training, and support their health and well-being while deployed.
