Purpose: To provide education and experience in the care of patients in a rural community family medicine setting.

Objectives: Following successful completion of this elective, the <u>student</u> will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate accurate and efficient oral presentations and thorough medical record documentations.
- 2. Demonstrate effective communication skills with patients and staff.
- 3. Formulate appropriate differential diagnoses.
- 4. Describe basic aspects of the "business of medicine", such as national and local healthcare economics, patient and staff scheduling, office staff management, and billing and coding.
- 5. Perform basic procedures in the office setting and interpret basic laboratory, imaging, and pathology studies.
- 6. Discuss those experiences that bring satisfaction and joy in the daily practice of medicine

Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Medical care of all ages.
- 2. Addiction counseling and treatment.
- 3. Family healthcare delivery in a variety of patient settings including inpatient, outpatient, and nursing home.
- 4. Assisting the preceptor in the performance of procedures common to the outpatient practice of a family physician including mole removal/sutures/simple fracture care/joint injections and other typical family physician outpatient procedures.

<u>Criteria for Grading</u>: During and following this elective, the <u>preceptor</u> will:

- 1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
- 2. Evaluate by direct observation and provide feedback to the student regarding:
 - a. Data gathering practices
 - b. Communication skills
 - c. Documentation skills
 - d. Diagnostic reasoning skills
 - e. Procedural skills
 - f. Clinical management and patient education skills
