1. Describe and understand the scope of care in a rural family medicine clinic.

- 3. Demonstrate competence in the diagnosis and management of patients in settings with limited resources.
- 4. Participation as a physician community member.

Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Functioning as an intern, under supervision of medical staff.
- 2. "Call" under the supervision of the preceptor.
- 3. Discussion of topics related to current cases.
- 4. Participation as a physician a community member.

- 2. Evaluate by direct observation the student's verbal presentations of patients.
- 3. Evaluate direct observation the student's approach to patient's problems.
- 4. Evaluate by direct observation the student's clinical skills.
- 5. Review and evaluate chart documentation skills.
