Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Hospital rounds on the Family Practice Teaching Service.
- 2. Patient work-ups in hospital.
- 3. Outpatient clinic.
- 4. Medical, pediatric, geriatric, and behavioral science lectures of the family practice residency program.
