## **Objectives:** Following successful completion of this elective, the <u>student</u> will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate refined skills in general history taking, physical examination, and plans for patient management.
- 2. Act and function as a resident with order counter signature.
- 3. Perform selected procedures with appropriate supervision.
- 4. Demonstrate improved skills in reporting, interpretation, and management of internal medicine.
- 5. Demonstrate improved skills in the use of evidence-based medicine for patient care.

## **Instructional Activities:** During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Performance of written histories and physicals on 2-3 inpatients per week on the medical service.
- 2. Presentation of all patients assigned to the student on admission and subsequent follow-up to the attending.
- 3. Attendance at all case conferences, noon conferences, and subspecialty conferences where appropriate.
- 4. Review of selected references for evidence-based support of patient care.

## **<u>Criteria for Grading</u>**: During and following this elective, the <u>preceptor</u> will:

- 1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
- 2. Review and evaluate the student's written histories and physicals along with progress notes.
- 3. Directly observe the student's case presentations and physical examination skills.
- 4. Directly observe the student's interpretive and patient management skills.
