Objectives: Following successful completion of this elective, the <u>student</u> will be able to:

1. Discuss the unique skills needed of an internist in the practice of internal medicine in a rural setting.

2. Function as an intern in the care of patients on a general medicine service, as well as those in the intensive care unit setting and emergency room.

Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Internal medicine consultations.
- 2. Internal medicine call with their preceptor.
- 3. Participating in assigned procedures under the supervision of the preceptor.
- 4. Presenting one patient case or topic at clinical conference.
- 5. Daily didactic teaching with the preceptor.

<u>Criteria for Grading</u>: During and following this elective, the <u>preceptor</u> will:

- 1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
- 2. Evaluate by direct observation the student's data-gathering, problem solving, and patient management skills.
- 3. Evaluate by direct observation the student's communication skills, interactions, and psychosocial integration with patients
- 4. Evaluate by direct observation the student's procedural skills.
- 5. Evaluate student's organizational, knowledge content, and presentation skills during the conference presentation
