In addition to the above requirements, you must complete **one** of the following options prior to entering the professional physical therapy program:

1. Complete a bachelor's **degree**.
2. UND Students: Complete ≥ 90 semester credit hours with the equivalent of an identified **minor** in a selected discipline.
3. UND or Transfer Students: Complete ≥ 90 semester credit hours with a **cognate** (i.e., area of concentration).
The cognate requires at least 20 hours in one discipline, with 8 of those hours at the 300 and/or 400 level(s).

As a student, **it is your responsibility** to make certain you have completed the pre-physical therapy curriculum, including pre-PT foundational science coursework, the Essential Studies requirements, and a degree or 90 semester credit hours with the equivalent of a minor or cognate. **Students must have successfully completed** all of the above coursework and the credit hour requirements by the end of the spring semester in which they are applying.

For selections purposes, grades from **only two retakes** will be used in the calculation of the Science GPA; the most recent grade will be chosen. To further clarify, ANY course which is retaken for a grade constitutes one retake. In addition, to be considered in SGPA calculations, **retake grades must be posted** on the transcript by the end of fall semester prior to selections.

Work Sheet for Minor or Cognate Courses

If you do not have a bachelor's degree prior to entering the professional physical therapy program, you will need at least 90 semester credit hours with the equivalent of a **minor** in a selected discipline **OR** at least 90 semester credit hours with a **cognate** (i.e., at least 20 hours in one discipline with 8 of those hours at the 300 and/or 400 levels).

Observation Hours: In addition to the pre-physical therapy coursework, you will need to complete at least 60 hours of observation and/or volunteer experience and/or work experience in health care. Forty of these 60 hours must be with a physical therapist. You are responsible for keeping a log of the dates, hours, duties, supervising therapist and facility for your application form. Observation in a variety of settings is helpful.

Selection for Admission to the professional program will be based upon SGPA, Interview Score, Letters of Reference, CGPA, and GRE Score (General Test). Please see the UND Physical Therapy website for information on the application process.
