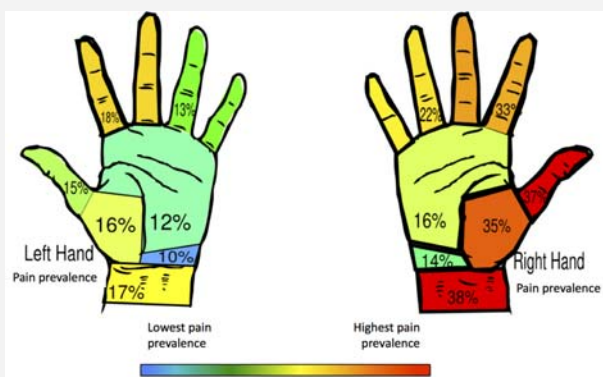
“Surgical Ergonomics”
