- Personally, engage in teaching pre-clinical and clinical UND learners as needed, including medical, and health professional students; and residents, and fellows
- Serve as a subject matter expert to advise the faculty in integrating OB/Gyn into the medical school curriculum
- Recruit and retain clinical faculty in OB/Gyn and manage the affairs of the department, such as promotion and tenure
- Mentor and support clinical faculty in their interactions with UND learners
- Encourage scholarship in OB/Gyn by departmental faculty and associated learners
- Participate in faculty governance at SMHS in parallel with the other clinical chairs, including attendance at regular clinical chairs' meetings, such as Faculty Council (FC); and Clinical Chairs; etc.
