

Vice President for Health Affairs

As chief health affairs academic officer and reporting directly to the President, the Vice President for Health Affairs is responsible for providing vision, leadership, and strategic planning for the institution's academic health affairs programs (as defined and determined by the President). Overall responsibilities include health affairs academic planning, support for the core mission of teaching, research, and public service, and coordination of interdepartmental affairs. The position provides leadership in the development, assessment, budgeting, and oversight for all health affairs academic initiatives as well as providing advocacy for health affairs initiatives in support of the University's mission.
