PA 525 is a new course developed to begin scholarly work earlier in the program. Previous PA 526 and PA 995 were each 3 credits. Change to move 1 credit from each to create PA 525. No increase in number of credits to complete program.

PA 565 is a new course developed to introduce professionalism earlier in the curriculum. One credit taken from PA 566 moved to PA 656. Name change requested for Professional Issues and Role Development (PIRD) to Professional Practice for sequence.

Changes proposed to allow more flexibility in scheduling clinical experiences required for the program. Currently 2/3 of the clinical curriculum require rotations in primary care. Propose to move a small portion of the required primary care hours to specialty rotations, which may still include primary care, allowing for increased flexibility in scheduling.
