Kathleen Ruff: Student Policy Discussion: Policy 4.4 Examination Question Appeals: This was brough up at the last Student Government meeting, asking if a student could challenge the Case Exam grading due to inconsistencies with answers and the answer guidelines provided. This is under the assumption that Case Exams are graded by different graders. When an exam is not within challenging points, have the exam regraded within 5% of passing. Similar how the Skills Exams are graded. The students want to have the full Case Exam graded by 2 other people and then take the average of the 3 scores. 	Information

	 In regards to the Question Challenge Policy, the students want it to be different than this policy. If you don't pass the exam on the challenge petition then this could be implemented. Dr. Porter said the Case Exams are graded per question and that question is graded by the same content expert for the whole class exam. Consistency per question by a content expert should be expected. Dr. Zelewski said that we have been talking about getting rid of the Question Challenge policy to get rid of the question Challenge policy and change it to a regrade similar to Clinical Skills. Dr. Ruit for 4.4 policy: we have and a meeting and want to have a committee to advise on this. Dr. Borg sets up parameters and if the regrade exam is within the appeals range, instead of an appeal have the regrade sent to a committee of graders would grade the exam again and if there were differences in grading to the negative, it would not negatively affect the student where only positive changes would be applied to the regrade. Kathleen Ruff will let student government know how Case Exams are graded now and that there is discussion on revisions to the policy. Dr. Van Eck said we would need Dr. Borg and Dr. Carr to discuss this possible policy addition or change. This possible policy addition or change also needs to go to P1C for discussion.
