LCME Element 3.1 Resident Participation in Medical Student Education

Each medical student in a medical education program participates in one or more required clinical experiences conducted in a health care setting in which he or she works with resident physicians currently enrolled in an accredited program of graduate medical education.

To ensure all medical students are meeting the above requirement, each medical student is required to work with resident physician-teachers for a total of 20 half-days across their required Phase 2 clerkships. This is a universal requirement regardless of campus assignment or structure of the Phase 2 curriculum.

This requirement will be monitored by the Assistant Dean of Phase 2/3 using data from student responses to a question on the rotation evaluation form.
