Statement:

The Undergraduate Medical Education Committee (UMEC) shall establish processes and procedures ensuring UNDSMHS Medical Education Program compliance with LCME accreditation Standards and Elements.

Processes:

Ongoing monitoring of the LCME Standards and Elements will be accomplished by continuous quality improvement processes. These processes will be managed by committees assigned to this task by the UMEC and assisted by Dean appointed administrators and staff.

Responsibilities:

These committees will be responsible for receiving and analyzing data pertinent to the monitoring of accreditation requirements and will make appropriate action plans where needed. Action plans will be approved and overseen by the UMEC.
