**Instructional Activities:** During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

1. Performance of written histories and physicals on 2-3 inpatients per week on the medical service.
2. Presentation of all patients assigned to the student on admission and subsequent follow-up to the attending.
3. Attendance at all case conferences, noon conferences, and subspecialty conferences where appropriate.
4. Review of selected references for evidence-based support of patient care.

**Criteria for Grading:** During and following this elective, the preceptor will:

1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
2. Review and evaluate the student's written histories and physicals along with progress notes.
3. Directly observe the student's case presentations and physical examination skills.
4. Directly observe the student's interpretive and patient management skills.
