Purpose: To provide education and experience in the care of gastroenterology patients.

Objectives: Following successful completion of this elective, the <u>student</u> will be able to:

1. Perform histories and physical examinations for gastroenterology patients. (Year 4-01)

2. Interpret laboratory and histological findings of gastroenterology patients. (Year 4-04)

- 3. Interpret gastrointestinal images. (Year 4-04)
- 4. Develop an accurate differential diagnosis for gastroenterology patients. (Year 4-03)
- 5. Develop an appropriate therapeutic plan for patients with various gastroenterological disorders. (Year 4-16)
- 6. Document accurately the history, physical exam, differential and proposed plan for gastroenterology patients. (Year 4-02)
- 7. Assist in gastroenterological procedures with appropriate preceptor supervision.
- 8. Communicate effectively and in a professional manner with members of the healthcare team regarding patient care including accurate oral case presentations. (Year 4-01, 4-07, 4-14)
- 9. Orally present to the preceptor information on gastroenterology topics using preceptor selected reading materials. (*Year 4-13*)

Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Evaluation of selected gastroenterology patients.
- 2. Discussions with the preceptor of diseases of the gastrointestinal tract including: the gallbladder, liver, pancreas, and the small and large bowel.
- 3. Observation and participation in gastrointestinal endoscopic procedures (to include colonoscopy, EGD, ERCP, capsule endoscopy), with a discussion of indications, techniques, and specific findings.
- 4. Case presentation and discussion of problems currently on the gastroenterology service.

Criteria for Grading: During and following this elective, the preceptor will:

- 1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
- 2. Evaluate by direct observation the student's ability to perform histories, physical examinations, and selected procedures on gastroenterology patients. (Objective 1, 7)
- 3. Evaluate by direct observation or review of written work the student's ability to interpret laboratory results, and histological and radiological studies for gastroenterology patients (Objective 2, 3)

- 4. Evaluate by direct observation the student's ability to communicate in a complete and professional fashion. (Objective 8)
- 5. Evaluate the student's written notes including clinic notes, histories and physicals, and consultation notes. (Objective 6)
- 6. Evaluate the student's oral presentations and ability to appropriately summarize, develop differential diagnoses, and therapeutic plans for selected gastroenterology patients. (Objective 8, 4, 5)
- 7. Evaluate by direct observation, the student's knowledge of preceptor selected reading materials on gastroenterology patients. (Objective 9)
