- 2. Demonstrate the clinical skills necessary for the diagnosis and management of a variety of common general internal medicine patients.
- 3. Demonstrate the ability to utilize the endocrine laboratory for aid in diagnosis by writing lab orders for patients with metabolic and endocrine disorders.
- 4. Demonstrate an understanding of the basic pathophysiology, treatment and management of common endocrine disease processes.

## **Instructional Activities:** During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. All aspects of the preceptor's practice including inpatient and outpatient environments.
- 2. Evaluation of patients with a wide variety of metabolic, endocrine, and general internal medicine conditions.

- 1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
- 2. Evaluate by direct observation the student's organizational and communication skills, and knowledge of basic endocrinology.
