You may begin collecting evidence toward completion of a badge any time, but you must complete the badges in chronological order.

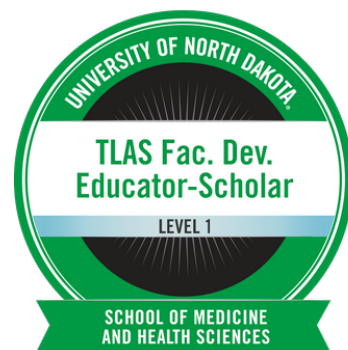

OR complete the following:

1. TWO of the following Professional Development Opportunities:
 - Attend 5 or more Teaching, Learning, and Scholarship (TLAS at Education Resources) faculty development workshops or sessions.
 - Complete 1 or more teaching, learning, or academic-focused book study (includes TLAS book studies and/or book studies offered by UND main campus or professional organizations).
 - Attend 1 or more faculty development workshops from the Teaching, Transformation, and Development Academy (TTaDa).
 - Other workshops or book studies may be substituted with prior approval.
2. ONE of the following areas (completing both earns Level 1 with Distinction**):
 - Teaching (complete all)
 - Teaching consult with a TLAS instructional designer

- Complete 1 or more teaching, learning, or academic-focused book study (includes TLAS book studies and/or book studies offered by UND main campus or professional organizations).
- Attend 1 or more faculty development workshops from the Teaching, Transformation, and Development Academy (TTaDa).
- Other workshops or book studies may be substituted with prior approval.



2. ONE of the following areas (completing both earns Level 2 with Distinction**):

- Implement research

- Consult with statistician
- Present research at conference OR submit article to refereed journal

1. TWO of the following Professional Development Opportunities*:

 - Lead an academic-focused book study
 - Design and deliver an interactive TLAS faculty development workshop for the SMHS community.
2. ONE of the following areas (completing both earns Level 3 with Distinction**):
 - Teaching (complete all)
 - Create learning asset using one or more technologies from the Media Recording Studio
 - Design, implement, and analyze results from a custom teaching, learning, or scholarship project with one or more faculty members from different departments or different schools
