Purpose: To allow students enrolled in the military Health Professions Scholarship Program or National Guard direct commissioned medical students to participate in their required military training and reflect on the impact this will have on their future role as a physician colleague and patient care provider. The timeline for this elective is dependent on the number of weeks the required military training is scheduled for. Military Leadership-I, offered in both June and July, is for training that lasts between 2-5 weeks. For required training sessions lasting >5 weeks, students can enroll in Military Leadership-I in June and Military Leadership II in July.

Objectives: Following successful completion of this elective, the student will be able to:

1. Complete the officer training course required by the military for the Health Professions Scholarship Program or other military training course affiliated with the students' future military career (Competency 1.1, 1.2, 4.3, 7.2, 7.5, 8.4, 8.6)
2. Generate weekly written reflections which connect the material learned in the military training course to your future role as a physician colleague and patient care provider. (Competency 1.3, 5.7, 7.3, 8.6)

Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

1. Completion of military training course required for the Health Professions Scholarship Program or National Guard direct commissioned medical student role
2. Weekly written reflections
3. Obtain written confirmation from military instructors, (DA Form 1059-Army Service School Academic Report), or course completion certificate indicating that they have successfully completed the training.

Grading for this elective is Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory.

Criteria for Grading: During and following this elective, the preceptor will:

1. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS phase I elective evaluation form.
2. By direct observation of written work evaluate the student's ability to connect lessons learned through their officer training to future roles as a physician (objective #2)
3. By direct review of military instructor documentation confirm successful completion of the officer training course (objective #1)
