**Purpose:** To provide education and experience in advanced general surgery care in an inpatient /outpatient setting.

## **Objectives:** Following successful completion of this elective, the <u>student</u> will be able to:

- 1. Execute basic operative principles and techniques. (Competency 3.6)

- 3. Execute the collection of relevant history of present illness and performance of a surgery focused physical examination. (Competency 3.1)
- 4. Generate a working diagnosis, and correlate this working diagnosis with operative and pathological findings. (Competency 3.3, 2.2, 2.3, 3.3)
- 5. Summarize and execute basic principles of surgical critical care. (Competency 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 3.5)
- 6. Successfully execute the ABCs of trauma care. (Competency 3.5, 3.6)
- 7. Summarize information contained in assigned readings. (Competency 1.3, 1.6, 1.8)
- 8. Choose to complete all elective related tasks in a professional manner. (Competency 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.6, 5.7, 5.8, 7.2, 7.4)

## **Instructional Activities:** During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Assisting with preoperative and postoperative care of surgical patients and participating with the preceptor in daily hospital rounds.
- 2. Scrubbing in the operating room in the role of first assistant and participating in instructional activities related to basic surgical technique and interventions.
- 3. Completion of and discussing daily reading assignments.
- 4. Participating in outpatient surgical care.

## **Criteria for Grading**: During and following this elective, the preceptor will:

- 1. Through discussion with the student evaluate the student's understanding of assigned reading (objective 7).
- 2. Evaluate by direct observation and from team member feedback the student's professionalism (objective 8).
- 3. Evaluate by direct observation the quality of the student's clinical and surgical skills (objective 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6).
- 4. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
