Purpose: To provide education and experience in the care of patients requiring interventional pain management

services

Objectives: Following successful completion of this elective, the <u>student</u> will be able to:

- 1. Execute evaluation of patients with chronic pain and generate appropriate management techniques (Competency 3.1, 3.2, 3.4)
- 2. Summarize indications for epidural steroid injections. (Competency 2.6, 2.7)
- 3. State potential complications of epidural steroid injections. (Competency 2.6, 2.7)
- 4. State the indications for, definition of and treatments used in multimodal treatment for patients with chronic pain. (competency 2.6)
- 5. Demonstrate application of the concepts learned in objective #4 during the development of management plans for patients. (competency 2.7, 3.4).
- 6. Summarize the use of IV sedation for procedures including indications, common medications used, monitoring required and potential complications. (competency 2.4, 2.6)
- 7. Choose to interact in a professional manner with an interdisciplinary treatment team. (Competency 7.2, 7.4, 7.5)
- 8. Summarize the strategies used to screen for narcotic overuse or misuse and demonstrate the ability to screen for narcotic overuse or misuse. (competency 2.1, 2.4, 2.5)

Instructional Activities: During this elective, the student will be involved in/experience:

- 1. Evaluation of patients with chronic pain in the outpatient setting
- 2. Observation and when appropriate (with proper supervision), participation in procedures used to treat chronic pain.
- 3. Readings and topic presentations as assigned by the preceptor regarding pain management.

<u>Criteria for Grading</u>: During and following this elective, the <u>preceptor</u> will:

- 1. By direct observation evaluate the student's assessment of patients with chronic pain (objective 1)
- 2. By direct observation or discussion evaluate the student's understanding of the indications for epidural steroid injections and the potential complications of these injections (Objective 2, 3)
- 3. By direct observation evaluate the student's understanding of multimodality treatment of chronic pain and the ability to use this in patient management plan creation. (objective 4, 5)
- 4. By direct observation or discussion, evaluate the student's understanding of principles of IV sedation. (Objective 6)
- 5. Evaluate the student's professionalism by direct observation and from feedback received from the staff (Objective 7)
- 6. By discussion with the student and direct observation, assess the student's knowledge of and ability to screen for narcotic overuse or misuse (objective 8).
- 7. Utilize the standardized UNDSMHS senior elective evaluation form.
