

LMH Therapy Services in Lawrence, KS is looking to fill a full-time outpatient physical therapist position. The position would see both general outpatient (MSK/neuro) and pelvic floor patients. LMH has a long standing pelvic floor service line that started in 2009. We currently have 1 full time pelvic floor therapist, and one part-time pelvic floor therapist on staff, with multiple years of experience between them.

The position would be 5 days a week in an outpatient clinic in the hospital. Patient care is one-on-one for 45 minute appointments. Mentorship and collaboration with both pelvic and general therapist is both supported and encouraged. LMH would be willing to discuss assistance continuing education and trainings through Herman and Wallace or APTA if applicants have not yet had pelvic floor training prior to applying for a position.

A unique feature (and my favorite part!) of the pelvic floor group at LMH, is that we participate in a collaborative care clinic with the Urology department. The clinic is called Sunflower Pelvic Health, and has had great success over the few years it has been established. Participating in the collaborative care environment with the urology group is an option in the future for the new hire.
