Job Description

Responsibilities

In this team-based role you will assist general surgery team members both in outpatient and inpatient (Robbinsdale Hospital, Maple Grove Hospital, and Buffalo Hospital) settings.

-Conduct history and physical examinations and diagnostic testing, develop diagnoses and treatment plans, and direct the course of patient care in the perioperative period

-First assist in the operating room in hospital and ambulatory surgical settings for both elective and urgent / emergent cases; help facilitate timeliness and selection of appropriate surgical instruments; utilize robotic equipment for the benefit of the patient and surgical team

-Counsel and involve patients in discussion of diagnostic information and treatment interventions, anticipated recovery and timeline, and pertinent lifestyle modifications

-Perform independent minor surgical interventions and procedures including wound care and debridement, drain care, suture and staple removal, removal or biopsy of skin lesions, and incision and drainage
