

Pre-Requisite Courses

Pre-professional students will be advised to select a four-year course of study plan from a major of personal interest. Students will be advised by both their major department and will require advisement through the pre-professional occupational therapy advisor. The following illustrates a potential pre-professional course of study, which illustrates required pre-requisite for the OTD. Students need a minimum of 90 credit hours prior to admission.

*With the exception of *Introduction to OT*, The UND OT Program does not accept OT course work from other institutions.

**Human Anatomy and Human Physiology are offered as a two-semester sequence, both semesters need to be completed.

Students should ensure that at least 8 credits are from upper level (300 or 400 numbers) courses.

When completing your Humanities courses, it is required that the 9 credit hours be in two departments and you must have a minimum of 3 credits in humanities and 3 credits in fine arts as part of the requirements of the essential studies program of the University of North Dakota.
