Residents as Teachers Procedure

LCME 3.1 Resident Participation in Medical Student Education

Each medical student in a medical education program participates in one or more required clinical experiences conducted in a health care setting in which he or she works with resident physicians currently enrolled in an accredited program of graduate medical education.

To ensure all students are meeting the above requirement, all students will be required to work with residents as teachers for 20 half-days within their required clerkships or acting internships at UND SMHS. This is a universal requirement regardless of campus assignment or traditional vs longitudinal curriculum.

This requirement will be monitored with a question on the rotation evaluation form which is tracked by the director of year 3 and 4.
