Statement:

The Office of Medical Accreditation shall establish processes and procedures in order to ensure UND SMHS medical education program compliance with LCME accreditation standards and elements.

Processes:

Ongoing monitoring of all LCME accreditation standards and elements will be accomplished by continuous review processes managed by committees assigned to this task by the Office of Medical Accreditation. Accreditation review committees will be comprised of faculty, administrators and students and assisted by appointed administrative staff.

Responsibilities:

Accreditation review committees will be responsible for receiving and analyzing data pertinent to the monitoring of accreditation requirements and will construct appropriate action plans where necessary. Action plans will be approved and overseen by the Office of Medical Accreditation.
