WHAT IS THE BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM (BRFSS)?

The BRFSS is a system of health-related telephone surveys that collect state data about:

- ✓ Health-Related Risk Behaviors
- ✓ Chronic Health Conditions
- ✓ Use of Preventive Services
- ✓ Data and Comprehensive Documentation Freely Available for Download

Online Analysis Tools:

Prevalence and Trends Data Tool:

- Select geographic location
- Select the health topic

Chronic Disease Indicators Tool

- Select geographic location
- Select from a variety of indicators
- Create charts/maps by health topics

Web Enabled Analysis Tool

- Create crosstabulation to produce frequencies for one or more variables
- Run Logistic Regressions calculations
