
Fetal Exposure Assessment

Exposure Risk Markers

- History of maternal substance abuse
- Premature birth (<36 weeks)
- Congenital Defects
- Family expresses concerns about substance abuse
- Mother smokes
- Mother has been in jail or prison

 Estimates days exposed during pregnancy.

Number of Binge Days = (c x 9) = ____ (4 or more drinks in one day) Estimates numbers of binge days.

Number of Drinks

During Pregnancy = (axbx40) = _____ (f) Estimates cumulative number of drinks during pregnancy.

Ounces of absolute alcohol = (f ÷ 2) = _____ Estimates cumulative absolute alcohol exposure during pregnancy.
