National Immunization Surveys (NIS)

The National Immunization Surveys (NIS) is the largest telephone survey in the nation and has become the gold standard for data on U.S. immunization rates. The surveys monitor vaccination coverage among:

- ✓ Children 19-35 months and teens 13-17 years
- ✓ Flu vaccinations for children 6 months to 17 years
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccination for eligible children and teens
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccination for adults 18 and older

Current Survey Types:

NIS – Child

- 2-part survey consisting of a household telephone survey and Immunization History Questionnaire
- Monitors vaccination coverage among 2-year-old children

NIS – Teen

- 2-part survey consisting of a household telephone survey and Immunization History Questionnaire
- Monitors vaccination coverage for adolescents 13-17 years old

NIS – CIM

- Monitors flu vaccination for children 6-18 months and 3-12 years
- Collects number of doses and whether it was a flu shot or flu nasal spray

NIS – CCM

- Monitors COVID-19 vaccination coverage among eligible children and teens

NIS – ACM

- Monitors COVID-19 vaccination uptake and confidence in vaccination among adults (18 and older)
