Step 1:

- Select a Starting Point/Topic
- Click content map to see topic and corresponding measures
- Click "+" icon next to Child and Family Health Measures to see list of topics (example: select Physical, Oral Health and Functional Status)
- Choose a topic to see survey questions (example: click Health Status)

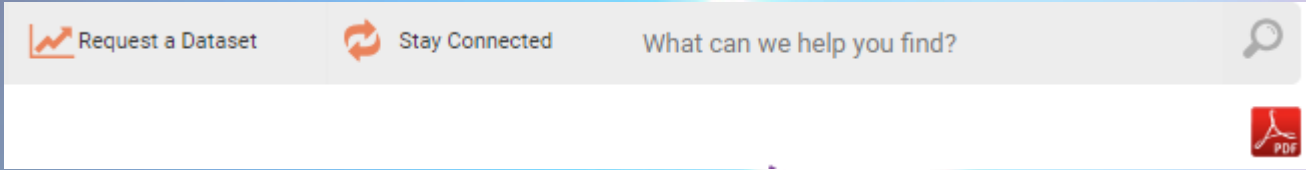
Step 4:

- New page displays table and graph including national data
- Hover over value to see description of data
- Graph of the indicator is displayed

Step 5:

- Top right corner of the page: Edit Search Criteria
- Change criteria to select state and subgroups
- Compare to national data

Data Output:



- At the top of the page, click the pdf icon to generate a pdf document you can download and save
- Click “Request a Dataset”
- Select “Click here to submit your Dataset Request” and fill out the requested information
